The purpose of this hearing is to accept public comment on the proposed FY 2024-25 Budget and proposed 2024 Tax Rate. The proposed 2024 Tax Rate is \$0.008834 per \$100 of valuation. The proposed tax rate is the no-new-revenue tax rate and will not increase taxes. 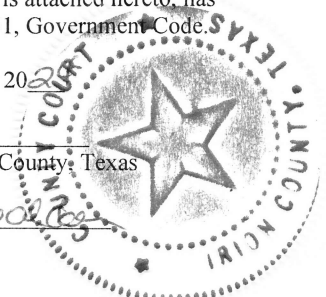
